1. Comb honey is judged on perfection in filling, uniformity of capping, neatness and cleanliness of section.
2. Extracted honey is judged on body, clarity, and cleanliness.
3. Bees wax is judged on color and purity.
4. Maple Syrup is judged on flavor, color, density and clarity.
5. Maple Sugar is judged on flavor, appearance and texture.
6. See Department 15 - Home Products, for exhibit entry and release times.
