Health Rules. See General Livestock information. Entry fee: \$4.00 per animal.

- 1. No swine showing clinical signs of contagious or infectious disease will be admitted to any show.
- 2. All show swine must be individually identified by either an ear tag, ear notch, or tattoo.
- 3. Interstate swine exhibited at a Pennsylvania show or fair must meet the Pennsylvania requirements and must be accompanied by an interstate health certificate to be eligible for entry. Out-of-state animals must test negative to brucellosis and pseudorabies within 30 days prior to the opening date of the Fair.
- 4. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) **issued after May 1** is required. An Animal Owner or Caretaker's Verification of Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship (VCPR) form must accompany each animal, and must be presented upon arrival at the Fair. **Market swine are exempt from the vaccination requirements.**

General Rules:

- 1. Exhibitors will be limited to two animals in each class except for group classes. The limit per group classes is one group per exhibitor. No market animal may be dual entered as a breeding animal for any species.
- 2. No equipment, feed, hay, bedding, etc. will be allowed to be stored in pens in the barns. These items must be kept in trailers.
- 3. All swine must be registered, and papers must be presented at time of entry.
- 4. The Swine Entry Form can be found at the back of this book or on the Premium Book page on the web site at www.southmountainfair.com and must be returned to the Department 5 chairperson.
