Address Numbers

Town Code requires that each building be identified by an address number:

- 1. At least 3" high,
- 2. At least 1/2 inch wide,
- 3. Sufficiently contrasting with the building as to be visible both day and night from the street.



REMINDERS

The Town Code requires that grass be kept 8 inches or less in height.

Signs may not be put on traffic signs, tree wells, utility poles, or in street right of ways

Use of town water on lawns, flowers, gardens is prohibited on all days between 9 am and 6 pm. Anyone violating this section of the Code shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and may be subject to a fine. This only applies to vegetation, you may use the water for everything else during this time frame!
